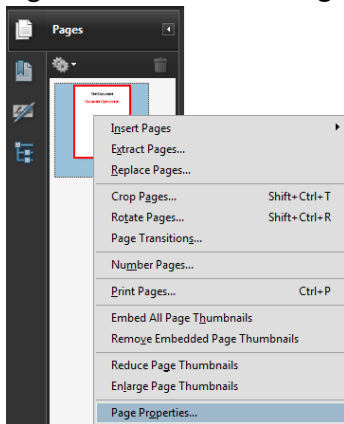


# Click-thru Agreements in PDF

Follow the instructions below to add a "click-thru" agreement to your PDF document

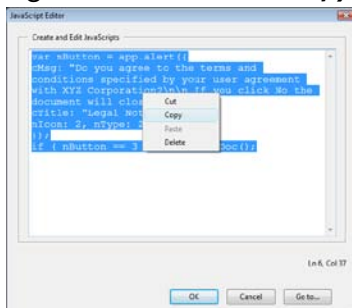
1. [Click here to open Pages Panel of this document](#)
2. Select the first page of the document
3. Right-click and choose **Page Properties**



4. Click the Actions tab
  - A. Click the Run a Javascript action
  - B. Click the **Edit** button

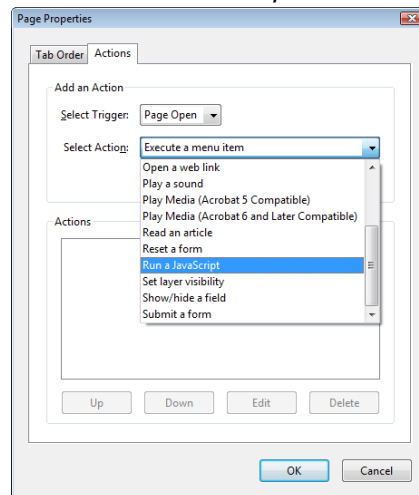


5. In the JavaScript Editor window
  - A. Select all the text
  - B. Right-click and choose **Copy**



6. Click **OK** twice.
7. Close the document.

8. Open the PDF to which you want to add the Click-thru agreement.
9. Open the Pages Panel
  - A. Select the first page of the document
  - B. Right-click and choose **Page Properties**
10. Click the Actions tab
11. From the Select Action menu, choose *Run a JavaScript*



12. Click the **Add** button
13. Right-click and choose Paste  
*To change the text, see note below.*
14. Click **OK** twice.
15. Save your document

## Editing the text for the JavaScript

- **Yellow** may be edited as needed.
- The `\n\n` is a line break. Ok to delete.
- The **Green** text is the window name.
