1. OVERVIEW

This update provides key fixes for InCopy CS3 in the areas of Text and Fonts, Dictionaries, Import/Export Graphics, and others.

2. INCOPY CS3 SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- 1,024x768 monitor resolution with 16-bit video card (24-bit screen display recommended)
- DVD-ROM drive

Documents

Memory leaks and performance degradation when zooming in to a page when “Ruler Per Page” setting is turned on in InCopy CS3. [1557664]

Word count occasionally incorrect after adding a note to text. [1531834]

Export Graphics

EPS export of a page fails when a group containing a Photoshop file with transparency intersects the page, but the Photoshop file itself does not appear on the page. [1490414]

Import Graphics

Placed InCopy file outputs to PDF and Print with visible tiling. Tiling is also visible on screen before outputting the file, if View > Display Performance > High Quality Display has been selected. [1577524]

Layout

On Mac, linked items may be found in the wrong folders after moving and/or renaming folders that contain the linked items. [1530330]

Text

Can't launch Adobe InCopy CS3 on Windows Danish platform after installation. [1507644]

InCopy CS3 incorrectly flags several common words as misspelled when using the German 2006 Reformed dictionary. [1485775]

InCopy CS3 unexpectedly quits when opening an InCopy CS3 Document without a language selected. [1566533]

InCopy CS3 unexpectedly quits when a user selects the Font Family or Font Style dropdown menus in the Character panel. [1565569]

When characters with diacritics begin a line after hyphenating, the diacritic should be dropped in

Dutch: Reformed. [1530327]

InCopy CS3 unexpectedly quits when using Winsoft-based spelling dictionaries to spell check Russian language text on Windows. [1562676]

Extra wrap is applied on INX import when overridden master object with text wrap overlaps object on layout page. [1575833]

Em dash at the end of a line of text is collapsing to a hyphen in a certain text frame size. [1579345]

Hyphens are counted as characters of a word when determining hyphenation break points, but are ignored when they conflict with hyphenation limits. [1579343]

Leading and trailing numbers are counted as characters when determining how to break a word for hyphenation. [1580804]

Unable to add word to third party provider's user dictionary in InCopy CS3. [1534513]

Stack overflow and unexpectedly quits with recursive loading of styles in the default workspace. [1527638]

InCopy CS3 unexpectedly quits when a user types a Korean character and a space in the Notes dialog with inline input turned on (Windows only). [1527748]

When a line breaks at a discretionary hyphen followed by a nonbreaking hyphen, the discretionary hyphen fails to draw. [1527793]

InCopy CS3 unexpectedly quits on launch in CoolType while building font menu previews if a corrupt font exists in the System Fonts folder. [1567612]

InCopy CS3 unexpectedly quits on launch in CoolType's CTInit if a corrupt font is present in the System Fonts folder. [1567624]

Fonts managed by third party font management utilities aren't consistently activated by InDesign CS3. [1561858]

AJ1-6N: JIS2004 glyphs aren't adopted when applying composite font or changing Kanji to Pr6N fonts. [1538238]

UI

Windows InCopy CS3 unexpectedly quits when using type ahead in the Quick Apply popup if it contains style groups. [1567574]

5. RESOLVED ISSUES FOR DEVELOPERS

This section provides a list of the resolved technical problems included as part of InCopy CS3 5.0.1 Debug update only.

InCopy CS3 Debug generates an assert when loading a plug-in that has a Window menu sub-menu. [1560672]

When a user does a context switch in InCopy CS3 Debug builds, the application generates the following assert: MRedrawInterrupter::CheckForInterrupt. [1532788]

Developer prefix IDs greater than 0x1000 cause an assert in StandardBossIterator when reading/writing persistent data. [1578785]
